6. New Business:

- **Per Sandy A.: What is the appropriate level of accomplishment from a sports team for the Academic Senate to recognize the coaches and players? Should Club sports be recognized as well as Varsity sports?**

Current Case: the Senate missed an opportunity to recognize the Football and Volleyball teams in January because we canceled the January meeting. When we tried to reschedule this recognition for the February meeting, Perk declined because of the activity surrounding Signing Day. Now it looks like we're putting off the recognition until April 3 (when we might also be recognizing the Men's Basketball team...). The question arose as to whether we would also recognize the Disc Golf team for their national championship. Now the Senate Executive Committee is struggling with the questions above and seeks guidance from this Committee.

The recognition is typically done at a Senate meeting following the season. This year it looks like this may take place at the April 3rd meeting.

Since club sports are RSO, should recognition come from student life side? Lots of discussion about this and it is believed clubs should use the RSO/Student Life route to make recognition requests to the Senate.

From the varsity sport side should we recognize at the conference championship level or above? Lots of discussion on saying conference championships and/or national level invitees should be the threshold for receiving recognition (individual and teams both).

Sandy will draft language for the committee to review and provide feedback to her prior to March 12th Senate executive committee meeting.
