MISSION: The mission of the University Graduate and Professional Council shall be to review and make recommendations regarding all graduate and professional degree policies and procedures. For the purposes of this document the term professional refers to the OD degree and the Pharm.D. degree on this campus

OBJECTIVES

1. Review and recommend institutional guidelines for minimum graduate/professional degree program admission and graduation requirements, including certificate programs.
2. Review and recommend institutional guidelines for graduate/professional degree student services both on and off campus.
3. Review and recommend institutional guidelines on graduate/professional degree faculty issues including expectations and qualifications of faculty who teach graduate/professional degree courses both on and off campus.
4. Serve as a liaison with college graduate/professional degree committees and graduate/professional degree program coordinators regarding institutional guidelines and student services.
5. Serve as a resource to the UCC, APRC and program faculty for the development and review of graduate/professional degree programs.

COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP

The committee shall be comprised of the following:

1. One member drawn from each graduate and professional program, one FLITE librarian, and a member drawn from each college without graduate programs (UC, CAS, COT, COPTS).
2. Ex-Officio members from Office of Academic Affairs, FSU-GR, and Extended Learning.
