- C. The discussion next focused on process considerations for the IEY Award going forward. Several issues were considered:
- i. Should self-nominations continue?
 - ii. How much supplemental information should be gathered from the nominees?
 - iii. Is a curriculum vita with appropriately emphasized information sufficient?
 - iv. Would it be appropriate to request nominees prepare a list of activities pertinent to each criterion?
 - v. Some of FSU Faculty awards requires nominees to prepare a 1-3 page philosophy statement that can be used in deliberations. Is this a process the IEY Award should emulate?
 - vi. Are there other items of information that will be useful?

Generally, the committee agreed to request some additional information as time allows in the 2016 process. Once this IEY Award cycle concludes, there will be a better idea of how some of these things might work.
