Committee Actions in 2019-2020: During the 2019/2020 academic year, the Professional Development Committee met three times. The first meeting set the timeline for the grant proposal due dates and award notification dates. At the second and third meetings, the Committee reviewed six applications from five applicants representing four academic colleges and the Ferris Library for Information, Technology, and Education. Of these applications, the Committee voted to fully fund three proposals, partially fund one proposal, and two proposals were not funded. Two of the awards were never transferred because the events being canceled due to the Covid-19 pandemic. The total amount rewarded for the 2019/2020 academic year was \$15,850.40. The total amount canceled due to the pandemic was \$9,502. The awards are broken down in the following chart:
