OLD BUSINESS:

Round table – topics of interest.

Advising – My Degree not accurate until recently. Faculty may be reluctant to use. Members have a concern that this is not always a person identified in each college to enter exceptions.

Governor Snyder has implemented new legislation to provide funding to high school counselors for training on academic advising. It was suggested that Ferris offer CEUs in advising which would also provide a connection between high schools and Ferris. NEW BUSINESS:

Public safety discussion on guns on campus.

Bruce discussed the MI supreme court decision that universities have the right to uphold their own guidelines concerning guns on campus. This decision may impact community colleges. Our policies are reviewed each year. Neither concealed nor open carry is allowed on our campus. Is a person is found with a weapon they will be warned as a trespass violation. If they refuse to leave campus they will be arrested for trespassing. Those that wish to have a gun for hunting purposes may have public safety hold the gun, and be allowed to check it out for hunting.

Student issues.

Issues concerning 24 hour library usage has come up recently.

This committee should do a climate survey either in FSUS courses or campus wide. Determine if student government will be doing a student body survey in the near future. Do these surveys represent all students through the student government or are the surveys sent to all students? How can we capture the diversity of the university? Can we add questions concerning advising? Elisa will bring surveys from other areas next meeting. Sue will send an email to Joy and all colleges to inquire about surveys that are being done currently. It was suggested that the committee look at the link to surveys on the Student Affairs website.

Last year Bob shared recommendations with Senate at year-end meeting. He will bring these to the next meeting for review.
