HOUSING RENOVATIONS

There have been many inquiries regarding the work being done in Residence Halls, so we would like to share a little about the changes taking place. Many if not all of these renovations will be completed for the return of residents at move in.

In Clark Hall, renovations are occurring in the 1st and 2nd floor lounges in addition to the exterior curtain wall. A community kitchen similar to North Hall is being added to the 2nd floor lounge. There will also be new flooring and furniture on both floors, a new fitness room, a renovated bathroom and laundry room, and a new bank of mailboxes to replace the original ones. These exciting changes give a much needed face lift to Clark hall which opened in 1960. Renderings are available for viewing at the UC, Timme, and the Office of Housing & Residence Life in Cramer Hall.

Additionally, an honors commuter lounge is being added to the terrace level of Pickell Hall and a new ADA compliant lift will replace a noncompliant unit. Bond Hall will receive updated study lounges and kitchenettes. Smaller scale updates are occurring in Hallisy and Bond halls.
