  - e. Offices for Strength & Conditioning
  - f. Wet storage
  - g. New elevator
  - h. General storage
- 3. Renovation of existing lower level
  - a. Renovation of existing Sports Medicine area
  - b. Women's Track & Field locker room renovation
  - c. Women's Softball locker room renovation
  - d. Renovation of existing public restrooms
  - e. Create locker room for men's and women's athletic staff
  - f. Renovation of existing Volleyball locker room restroom and shower area
  - g. Women's Soccer locker room renovation
  - h. Men's Track & Field locker room renovation
  - i. Renovation of existing restroom and shower areas
  - j. New mechanical, electrical, and plumbing equipment and services as needed
