

Introduction:

Amazon purchases have become increasingly common on our University Purchasing Cards, and previously were done through personal accounts, or in some cases, a department's Prime Membership account. The new procedures for Amazon purchasing are for cardholders and/or departments to set up Amazon Business accounts in order to properly claim sales tax exemption along with other business benefits.

Initial Set-up:

- No cost to set up. Create a free account [here](#).
- Accounts can be created for individual cardholders or by department.
 - A designated department representative can [add individual cardholders](#) to the department's account.
- New accounts can be created or existing accounts can be moved over to a Business account.
 - Existing Prime Memberships should not be renewed and should be converted to a Business account once expired (may need to call to avoid automatic renewal).
- Open the account under the University's name and department's or individual's name, using a University [address](#) and ferris.edu email address.
- Upload Michigan [Sales Tax Certificate](#) to account.
 - The [Amazon Tax Exemption Tool](#) will guide you through the process of enrolling in the program. You can use this tool to update your status and edit or upload certificates.

Benefits of the Business Account:

- [Free Shipping](#) for orders of \$49 or more.
- [Business pricing](#) on select items.
- Sales tax exempt for eligible Amazon purchases.
 - The Amazon Tax Exemption Program (ATEP) allows Amazon Business customers to apply tax exemption status to [eligible purchases](#) from Amazon.com LLC, Amazon Digital Services LLC, Warehouse Deals LLC, Amazon Services LLC or other participating sellers.

Note: Business accounts should not be used for personal purchases, and FSU Purchasing Cards should not be associated with any Amazon accounts used for personal purchases.
