

What happens if I am registered for classes next semester?

- Undergraduates must apply for readmission online at www.ferris.edu/admissions/homepage.htm (exceptions for summer total withdrawals). Your future registered classes are dropped.
- Graduate students remain active for up to a year before they must reapply.

Will I owe the University money if I withdraw?

Most students who withdraw will owe the University money. You will be removed from your payment plan, making your full balance due. To inquire how a withdrawal will affect your account balance, please contact Student Financial Services at 231.591.3945. (You may leave a message, and someone will return your call.)

What happens to my financial aid?

- Your future financial aid may be cancelled. You must contact the Financial Aid Office at finaid@ferris.edu to determine what steps may be required to assure your future financial aid.
- You will begin to use your student loan grace period. Please complete Direct Loan Exit Counseling. (Health Professions, Nursing, Perkins, and Institutional Loans have separate loan exit counseling. You will receive an email from ECSI when you can complete the counseling.)
- Financial Aid is required to pro-rate your federal aid – which means they will determine how much of your federal financial aid you have earned by the withdrawal date. Any “unearned” federal financial aid must be returned to the appropriate federal program.

Will I get a tuition and housing refund if I withdraw?

The University Refund policy dictates the percentage of tuition and housing refunds based on the dates published on the Student Financial Services website. Once the half-way point of the semester is reached, there is no refund of tuition or housing fees.

If I have a credit balance on my account after I withdraw, when do I get the money?

All refunds will be processed within 3-4 weeks of your withdrawal. Please set up your direct deposit information in Ferris 360 if you have not already done so.

If I live on campus, how long do I have before I must move out?

- Residence Halls: You must vacate your room within 48 hours of submitting the request to withdraw.
- Townhouses: Move out varies. Please call the Housing Main Line for questions: 231.591.3745

How do I begin the withdrawal process?

- Log in to Ferris 360. In the Registration Widget, click on Student Academic Dashboard, click the link “Request a Total Withdrawal” or type Total Withdrawal in the Search box. Select the Total Withdrawal Link and complete the steps.
- To amend your withdrawal status to a Medical Withdrawal, you must contact the Birkam Health Center at 231.591.5968.
