FERRIS YOUTH INITIATIVE JOHNSON SCHOLARSHIP

APPLICATION

Ferris State University is proud to announce the Ferris Youth Initiative (FYI). The overall goal of this program is to increase higher education opportunities for young people who are low-income (Pell eligible as determined by the Free Application for Federal Student Aid) and are alumni of foster care. This program provides support that promotes success and well-being throughout the undergraduate experience at Ferris State. Recipients of the FYI Scholarship may receive up to \$4,000 per year, to be applied to any direct cost at Ferris (tuition/fees, room/board, and/or books/supplies). The FYI program is limited to 25 students, so please apply early. Application deadline for incoming Fall students is July 1. Application deadline for incoming Spring students is November 1.

CRITERIA

To be eligible for the scholarship, applicants must:

1. Be accepted for admission to Ferris State University
2. Be enrolled as a full-time student and attending classes on the Big Rapids Campus
3. Be under 23 years of age at the start of the Ferris Youth Initiative program
4. Qualify for the Chaffee/Youth in Transition (YIT) or Refugee Educational Voucher (REV)
5. Submit Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) each year/demonstrate unmet needs
6. Meet the qualifications set forth by the Michigan Dept. of Health and Human Services criteria

RENEWAL CRITERIA

The FYI scholarship can be renewed for as long as the student files a FAFSA each year and meets FYI Program Requirements.
