1. How was the grant used to address a diversity or inclusion related goal?

The grant money was used to fund student creation of Adobe Captivate videos that could be used with voice-overs from multiple languages to assist students in the Intensive English Program.

Students in the Intensive English Program who speak Arabic, Hindi, and Korean benefited from this grant.

Jody and Chuck worked together to assign the creation of the video portion of the project for the following items:

- a. Changing password
- b. Forgot password
- c. Viewing student schedules

The videos and scripts were created by student employees. The scripts were written in English and translated by student volunteers who speak both English and a second language. Shana was responsible for assisting Jody with finding students who could translate the script to the video until she moved to another position at the University. Lisa vonReichbaurer took over in November 2012.

Two students in the TAC's Technical Education & Outreach team, Anna Boles and Jennifer Warden, created the videos and worked with Lisa's students to record the voiceovers. These videos were then posted on the TAC's Youtube channel at http://www.youtube.com/techassistancecenter.

4. What is your overall assessment of the project's impact on the Ferris community? How did this impact compare to what you expected?

I feel the videos were well received by the IEP students and helped them to understand how to use Ferris technology resources. The real test will be next fall when there are more students coming in new to campus.

My students enjoyed working with the international students on this project. Our team is trying to reach out to other departments on campus and provide them with training that meets their specific needs on Ferris technologies.
