Tuition and Student Fees Committee

The Tuition and Student Fees Committee is a campus-wide committee charged by the President to review and make advisory recommendations regarding tuition policies, tuition rates, tuition structures and student fees.

The Committee is comprised of members representing the following campus units:

- Budgetary Planning & Analysis Office - the budget director chairs the Committee
- Faculty – one professor selected by the Academic Senate to serve a two-year appointment
- Student – one student selected by the Student Government Association

Representatives from the following campus offices:

- Academic Affairs
- Auxiliary Enterprises
- Enrollment Services
- Financial Aid Office
- Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University
- Student Affairs
- Student Financial Services
- University Advancement and Marketing

The Committee typically meets from January to early April at which time submits their advisory recommendations to the President.
