They are as follows: 1. Many schools offer internal training, such as Safe Zone training; 2. Guest speakers were often used to explore a specific topic; and 3. On-line based training was an option. Nick researched a few on-line training options and was able to provide a demo of Kognito. After reviewing a small portion of the demo, committee members were able to provide their feedback on whether to use Kognito as a resource option for our faculty/staff. Joy will send a link to the demo to all committee members and ask that everyone view it prior to our next meeting, and be ready to provide suggestions/feedback as to whether or not to continue moving forward on pursuing this as an option to purchase as a training resource.
