¹ **CMU** – Undergraduate students enrolling prior to Fall 2008 are covered by The CMU Promise, a 5-year guaranteed tuition plan. Graduate students and undergraduate students enrolling Fall 2008 and beyond will have tuition rates set annually by the Board of Trustees. For graduate students, an additional \$12/credit hour is assessed for most Physical Therapy courses.

² **EMU** – Tuition, fees, Room & Board incurred a 0% increase from 2009-10 to 2010-11. The following also remained the same: A General Education Program Fee of \$14.50/cr. hr. is assessed on each 100 level course in Mathematics, Communications, English, and Science. All Military Science courses are assessed a \$11/cr. hr. fee. Program fees are assessed for 300-499 course level courses at the following rates: Foreign Language = \$41.25 per credit hour. Education (all), Health & Human Services (except Nursing), Fine Art (all) = \$47.50/cr. hr. Science (Biol, Chem, Comp. Sci., Math, Phys. Astronomy), Business (all), and Technology = \$54.00/cr. hr. Nursing = \$68.50/cr. hr. All other courses (not covered above) = \$28.50/cr. hr. Online course fees are \$44.50 per credit hour for all online courses. There is a Student Teaching fee of \$135.00 per class. Please note also that beginning this year, the Fast Track, Record Initiation, and Orientation Fees will be combined into one New Student Fee: Freshmen = \$300, UG Transfer = \$150, and Post-Baccalaureate = \$100.

³ **LSSU** – An additional \$60/cr. is assessed for all engineering courses. An additional \$10/cr. is assessed for all chemistry courses. An additional \$20/cr. is assessed for all nursing and paramedic technology courses. An activity course fee of \$20 per credit is applied to one-credit courses in music and recreation.

⁴ **MSU** – Effective in Fall 2010, the Registration/Energy fee is no longer being charged.

⁵ **MTU** – Engineering & Computer Science undergraduates taking fewer than 6 credits and graduate students taking fewer than 5 credits are assessed a program fee of \$330/semester. Engineering & Computer Science undergraduates taking 6 credits or more and graduate students taking 5 credits or more are assessed a program fee of \$660/semester. The Engineering/Computer Science program fee applies to all students in the College of Engineering - all majors except Applied Geophysics, Geology, and Geophysics and to all students in Computer Science in the College of Science and Arts. This fee does not apply to first-year students. The Graduate Resident and Non-Resident per credit rate for Applied Science Education and on-campus Peace Corps students is \$431/credit. The Graduate Resident and Non-Resident per credit rate for Graduate Students who are in the Research Only Mode is \$208/credit. The on-line MBA program is \$38,000 - this includes the cost of tuition for the two-year degree and three required residencies, which includes housing and most meals, but not transportation.

⁶ **NMU** – A tuition credit of \$192 per full-time resident undergraduate student was applied in Fall 2010 semester from Federal ARRA Funds to help mitigate the increase in tuition and fees. An additional \$75/semester program fee is assessed to all BSN and MSN Nursing students, Chemistry lab courses are assessed an additional \$40/course, Biology lab courses are assessed an additional \$25/course.

⁷ **OU** – Oakland University does not charge fees to its students; mandatory or non-mandatory.
