Program fees are assessed for 300-499 course levels at the following rates: Education, Arts, Humanities, & Social Sciences = \$40.75/cr. hr. Science (Biol, Chem, Comp. Sci., Math, Phys. Astronomy), Business (all), and Technology, Health Sciences, HPHP, Social Work = \$46.5/cr. hr. Nursing = \$59/cr. hr. All other courses (not covered above) = \$32/cr.hr. for UG. Online course fees are \$62.00/cr.hr. for all online courses. There is a Student Teaching fee of \$175.00 per class.

²**GVSU** - An Additional \$20/cr. is assessed for International Studies, and Honors (course 200 level & above).
