I will be unable to attend the February 4, 2022 meeting either in person or by phone. Please accept this written report of FSUEA activities.

COVID-19 has curtailed our social calendar but we did manage to have our in-person Holiday dinner at the University Center on December 15, 2021. It was attended by about 35 people, including Bob Murray from UA&M who gave us an update on advancement happenings.

Our Endowment fund, as of 01/27/2022, had a book value of \$154,807 and a market value of \$193,173.38 as of 09/30/2021.

Our annual bucket campaign netted donations of \$6,150, so with the Ferris Futures match, we added \$12,300 to the fund.

We continue to meet bi-monthly on the first Monday of the month. Our February meeting will be on the 7th at which time we will hopefully finish updating our constitution and bylaws. The changes to these two documents will be submitted to the general membership for approval at our annual meeting in May, 2022.
