For those of you who live in or go to Florida in the winter, I hope you and your property survived Hurricane Ian. My son lives in Cape Coral and he and his family

Having visited the Ft. Myers area several times, I understand the magnitude of the damage. Sanibel Island, Captiva Island, and Ft. Myers Beach were devastated. To rebuild or not is the question. Lee county schools are closed and many will not open for several weeks. It will take years and billions of dollars to rebuild the area. My other son and his family live in Oregon. In the past few years, there have been many wild fires near them. Sometimes they have to curtail outdoor activities because the air quality is so bad. Due to coastal storms and western wild fires and drought, Michigan seems like a great place to live. A rare tornado or blizzard is nothing compared to the problems that other areas of the country (and the world) experience regularly.

Changing the subject to closer to home, I went to Dr. Pink's inauguration ceremony on October 8, 2022. It was marvelous.

Emeriti Endowment Update

As of 09/30/22, the Book Value of our endowment (total donations) was \$157,857.00 and as of 06/30/22, the Market Value (total donations plus accrued interest) was \$200,009.62. For the academic year 2022/23, we were able to award 5 scholarships, each of which was approximately \$1,470. The following students received the awards:
