KCXX XXX Independent Study provides students the opportunity to study/work on a body of experiences or specific course content independently under the guidance of a faculty member. In this case the student and faculty determine the course of study/expectations and schedule consulting/monitoring and evaluation sessions (one hour per week, required) outside an existing scheduled course with the faculty. This offering is subject to agreement with a named faculty member (must be full-time term, tenured or tenure track), submission of a course outline or syllabus, program chair approval and availability of resources. Independent Study courses do not contribute to a teaching load for faculty and do not contribute to a course load (Independent Study students are not counted in a course head count). Faculty are limited to 2 Independent Study students per semester and are compensated as prescribed in the contract. Application forms are required, available at Student Services and Forms-R-Us.
