Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) for Transfer of Associate of Applied Science degree from Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana

to

Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University

An Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree is the designed pathway for Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana students planning to join the workforce after graduation. The pathway for Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana students with an initial transfer objective is the Associate of Science (AS) or Associate of Arts (AA) degree. However, students with an earned AAS degree may decide to pursue transfer into a four-year program after completing the AAS degree.

With that intention, this MOU is an agreement between Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana and Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University for the transfer of Associate of Applied Science (AAS) degree in Environmental Design from Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana to Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Design.

- An AS/AA articulation agreement between Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana and Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University for the program area(s) of this MOU is completed and current.
- 2. Students must meet the admission and graduation requirements for Ivy Tech Community College of Indiana and Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University.
- 3. Kendall College of Art and Design of Ferris State University will apply 60 credits of the AAS degree directly toward the total required credits of 120 for Bachelor of Fine Arts in Interior Design. A total of 60 credits are required to complete the receiving program degree after the transfer-in of the AAS degree.
- 4. This MOU is effective for AAS degrees earned after April 4th, 2019.
- 5. This MOU is effective for five years from the effective date (#4 above) or 90 days written notice of cancellation of the MOU received by either institution delivered to the applicable institution's Office of the Provost.
