

Ferris State University School of Education Teacher Candidate Graduation Rates

The following tables show the 3 to 7-year graduation rates for the Fall 2007 to Fall 2011 Teacher Candidate (TC) cohorts for the Elementary and Secondary programs. The rates are calculated from the point at which students are accepted into Level 2 (Teacher Candidacy), which is generally near the end of their second year or beginning of their third year. Prior to entry and acceptance as teacher candidates, students must complete at least 35 credit hours of general education credit, all Level I Professional Education coursework, meet specified GPA requirements, and passed the SAT with scores that meet CAEP/SOE standards.
