

PETER VS. THE WOLF

Peter VS. the Wolf begins with the sounds of a prison break, with a police radio announcing that the Wolf has just escaped from the zoo. To elude the police pursuit, the Wolf runs into a concert hall, where he pleads his case with the audience.

He tells the audience he never ate the duck, claims that he was “framed,” and then begins to tell the story of what happened at his trial. But before the show ends, the truth of the matter is revealed to the audience – in no uncertain terms!

JUSTIN LOCKE

Justin Locke arrived in Boston at age 18 to go to music school, and within a year he found himself busy as a freelance bass player. His 18-year stint with the Boston Pops included playing the Bicentennial Concert in 1976 with Arthur Fielder, which is in the Guinness Book of World Records as the largest audience ever at a classical music concert.

After leaving the Boston Pops, he became a producer of fund-raising videos which helped to raise over \$200 million for various non-profit organizations all over the United States. He continues his career now as management coach, speaker, and author.

Justin's books include *Real Men Don't Rehearse*, a fun collection of his favorite "gig disaster stories" from his Pops playing days. His more recent books include *Principles of Applied Stupidity* (or, undoing the effects of industrial era education), and *Getting in Touch with Your Inner Rich Kid*, a look at the underlying emotions of money and wealth.

Justin is also the author of *Peter VS. the Wolf*. This piece has been performed by orchestras all over the world, in such prestigious venues as the Theatro Municipal of Rio de Janeiro, the State Theater of Nuremberg, and the Berlin Konzerthaus.

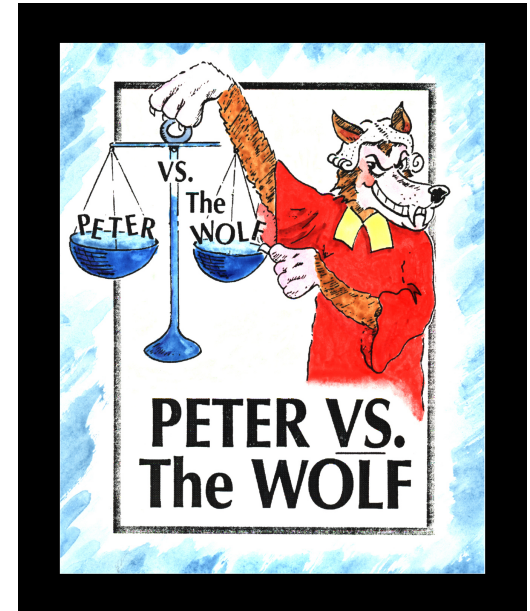
