DR. RICHARD SCOTT COHEN, MUSICAL DIRECTOR

Dr. Cohen is Professor of Music and Director of Instrumental Concert Ensembles at Ferris State University. He directs the FSU West Central Concert Band, the FSU Symphony Band, the Ferris Community Summer Band, and the FSU West Central Chamber Orchestra. He has partnered concerts with community organizations and charities such as Big Brothers Big Sisters, Project Starburst Food Pantry, Toys for Tots, and the Salvation Army, Spectrum Health Big Rapids Hospital Auxiliary, Festival of the Arts, Mecosta-Osceola Area Resource Center (MOARC), Tuba Bach Chamber Music Series, Canadian Lakes Association, Big Rapids Old Jail, several veterans organizations, and numerous campus organizations. He has served on local boards of directors of the Big Rapids Rotary Club, Art Works, Festival of the Arts, Tuba Bach Chamber Music Series, City of Big Rapids Park & Recreation Board, Big Rapids Band Shell Development Committee, and Big Rapids Band Shell Programming Committee. Cohen was the 2012 recipient of the MCMC Foundation's Northern Lights Award for the Arts. He is active in numerous national and international associations, and as a conductor, trombonist, composer, music adjudicator, researcher, author and lecturer. A native of Chicago, he is a Phi Beta Kappa graduate from the University of Illinois, a doctoral conducting graduate from Northwestern University, and a Fulbright Scholar to Spain.
