Scott Cohen is Professor of Music and Director of Instrumental Concert Ensembles at Ferris State University. He is director of the FSU West Central Chamber Orchestra, as well as of the FSU West Central Concert Band, the FSU Symphony Band, and the FSU Community Summer Band. Dr. Cohen also teaches classes in music appreciation and beginning class piano. A native of Chicago, he is a Phi Beta Kappa scholar from the University of Illinois, holds masters and doctorate degrees in conducting from Northwestern University, and is a former Fulbright Scholar to Spain. He is active as a conductor, trombonist, composer, arranger, music adjudicator, clinician, researcher, author, translator and lecturer throughout the United States, Canada, Europe and Asia.

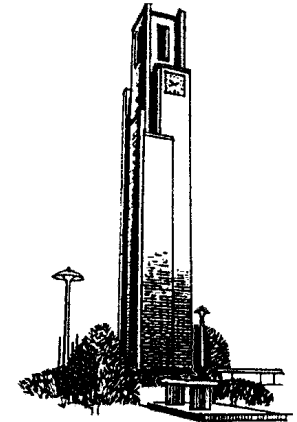
