Jason DaDay is an Assistant Director of Admissions at Ferris State University. He is a graduate of Big Rapids High School and Ferris State University. He serves as the public address announcer for Ferris State hockey and spent many years on the radio calling Ferris State football and basketball games. In 2010 Jason was honored as one of five Ferris employees honored with the Distinguished Staff Award.



Noah Mallett is a 13-year-old percussionist from Big Rapids, where he attends Crossroads Charter Academy. He studies percussion at Michigan State University with Gwen Dease and Tia Harvey Noah, and he is a member of the Grand Rapids Youth Symphony. Noah has performed with renowned artists such as Bernie Dressel, Alvin Waddles, Rick Hicks and Larry Ochiltree. Earlier this month he performed with Opera Grand Rapids. He has also been a featured soloist and arranger with the Ferris State University Summer Band, and for the Tuba Bach Chamber Music Festival. Noah also composes operas and instrumental music. His work for marimba and vibraphone was a winning entry featured at the Honors Composition Concert at the Michigan Music Conference last month.



Dr. Edward K. Mallett is a Big Rapids native, and the founder and Artistic Director of the Tuba Bach Chamber Music Festival. He earned his undergraduate degree in music from Central Michigan University, and his master and doctorate degrees in music from Michigan State University. He is recognized internationally as a performer on the tuba and euphonium, and he is one of the world’s foremost authorities on the double bell euphonium. Ed performs throughout Michigan with his wife, Adriana, as *Tuba Tales*, a literacy and music program they developed together for elementary aged students. As a composer, Ed has had his works performed throughout the world. In 1998 his work *Tanka and Haiku: August 1945* was nominated for the Pulitzer Prize in Music.
