RADIOGRAPHY PROGRAM PROGRESSION POLICY

- A grade of "C" or higher is required for all Radiography program requirements.
- Any student that receives less than a "C" in one radiography course must stop the radiography program sequence. They may return to repeat the course the next time it is offered (if a seat is available in the program).
- A student receiving a grade of less than a "C" (including a "W") in any two radiography courses (or two unsuccessful attempts in the same RADI course) will be dismissed from the program.
- All general education requirements must be completed before internship. Any student not completing all general education requirements will not be allowed to enter internship.
- Students may need to relocate for clinical internship during the second year of the program.
- Students may need to work weekends and afternoon shifts during the second year of the program while on internship. Internship is 40 hours a week for three semesters.
 Internship hours are unpaid.
- Any student with a conviction record is advised to contact the American Registry of Radiologic Technologist at 651-687-0048 or www.arrt.org in regard to his/her ability to take the registry upon completion of the program.
