PROGRESSION POLICY

- A letter grade of "C" or higher is required for all Nuclear Medicine Technology Program requirements including core and general education courses.
 - Any student who receives less than a letter grade of "C" in any Nuclear Medicine Technology course must stop the Nuclear Medicine Technology sequence. They must repeat the course the next time it is offered if there is a seat available.
 - Two unsuccessful attempts (less than a letter grade of "C") in any two Nuclear Medicine Technology courses (or two unsuccessful attempts in the same Nuclear Medicine Technology course) will result in dismissal from the program.
- All general education requirements except COHP 450 must be completed prior to the start of internship. Any student not in compliance may not be allowed to start internship.
- Students in the NMT Program must complete the professional sequence in no more than 3 years. Students who do not complete the program in the stipulated time will be required to restart the professional sequence.
