To graduate with BS in Health Information Management, student must have 3 courses with a minimum of 9 credits that meet Culture Competency with at least one of these courses at the 200 level or higher; no more than 5 credit hours can have the Activities attribute. The three courses must be from at least two different disciplines.

Student must have 3 courses with a minimum of 9 credits with the Self and Society attribute with at least one of these courses at the 200 level or higher. The 3 courses must be from at least two different disciplines. At least 1 of the 3 courses must have the Self and Society Foundation attribute.

If not met by courses taken for Culture, Self and Society, or MTA, a student must meet the following:  
1 course with the Global Diversity attribute and 1 course with the U.S. Diversity attribute.

All of the professional courses (MRIS, HCSA, COHP, ENGL 3-- ) are offered online. MGMT 301 is also offered online. General education courses can be taken at a college or university of student's choice. These classes include the equivalents for ACCT 201 Principles of Accounting 1, Scientific understanding elective, MATH 115 Intermediate Algebra or ACT 24 or higher, Self and Society, and Culture Competency.
