

Certificate in Long Term Care

In January of 2015 the state of Michigan put new rules in place for the licensure of nursing home administrators. These new rules include a requirement for applicants seeking licensure to complete 9 college credits in long term care covering certain topics. This certificate meets those requirements. The certificate consists of 4 courses:

HCSA 260 Survey of Long Term Care	3 Credits
HCSA 461 Nursing Home Administration	3 Credits
HCSA 463 Roles of Health Care Professions in LTC	1 Credit
HCSA 465 Long Term Care Facilities Management	2 Credits

All of these courses are taught on-line.
