



## OFFERINGS

Each year 64 students are admitted to the traditional program for either fall (August start) or spring (January start) semesters. Students apply to the professional sequence between March 15 and March 30 for both the fall and spring start. The professional sequence of the traditional BSN program is scheduled year around for 5 consecutive semesters, including summers. This allows students to complete the professional sequence (i.e. NURS courses) in two calendar years.

Students are admitted based upon their semester of qualification for the program. High School students may apply at the end of their graduate to sit for the R.N. licensure exam (NCLEX).

### Admission

At Ferris, students must fulfill entrance requirements for the BSN program before beginning the clinical experiences, which are provided to small groups of students in hospitals and community settings within the DUHODOWXGHODUBIGPLWWHGDTXDXQIMXGHQVV until they complete the requirements to qualify for the professional sequence of the nursing program. For admission to the professional nursing sequence: specific pre-requisite courses with must be successfully completed by the end of the Spring Semester to qualify for entry into the professional sequence.

### Qualifying

1. Cumulative Grade Point Average of 2.7 or higher.
2. Completion of all science and math courses in no more WDDWWHPSWLDORRIFRXUHWRHUUDJUDGHR!% RUKJKIU
3. Math ACT score of 24/SAT score of 580 or higher or 0\$RUZWDJUDGHR!% -RUKJKIU
4. Completion of all required pre-requisite courses as outlined on the BSN qualification check sheet.
