Sanitize Electronic Devices

Headphones, Earbuds, Airpods, Smart Watches and Fitness Trackers, Roku, Firestick, Smart Speaker, Gaming Consoles and Controllers, Remote Controllers

Supplies Needed to Clean and Sanitize your Devices

- Distilled water
- Isopropyl alcohol, 70%
- Spray bottle
- Microfiber or lens cleaning, lint-free cloth
- Q-Tips

** In a small spray bottle, mix a one-to-one ratio of distilled water and 70% isopropyl alcohol. The distilled water is essential if you live in an area that has hard water, which is filled with microscopic minerals that can scratch the surfaces. Give the bottle a good shake.

1. Always unplug and turn off your device prior to disinfecting.
2. Spray the isopropyl alcohol and water mixture onto a microfiber cloth (do not directly spray device).
3. After spraying cloth, wipe device thoroughly.
4. Dip Q-Tip in mixture to allow cleaning small crevices.

Sanitize your Laptop Screens or Computer Monitors

Warning! Do not use Windex or window cleaner on a laptop screen or computer monitor.

- Make sure Laptop is unplugged and powered off. Make sure desktop monitor is turned off.
- For touch screens, use water or eyeglass cleaner applied to a microfiber cloth.
- LCD screen use microfiber cloth to remove dust
