

Sanitize Your Keyboard

Supplies Needed to Clean and Sanitize your Keyboard

- Compressed Air
- Isopropyl Alcohol, 70%
- Q-Tips
- Microfiber lint free cloth
- 1. Shut down the computer and detach all connecting cables
- 2. Turn the keyboard upside down to shake out loose debris. Use compressed air to blow dust and debris out from the keys (keep nozzle ½ inch above keyboard at all times).



3. Clean around the keys with a cotton swab dipped in isopropyl alcohol.



4. Clean the keyboard with a cloth dampened in isopropyl alcohol.



5. Polish the keyboard with a microfiber lint-free cloth.
