## Important Gameday Details For Aug. 30 Football Opener Due To Thursday Evening Challenges



Greetings from Bulldog Athletics,

In collaboration with Student Affairs and the entire Bulldog Beginnings Committee, we are proud to host our 2018 "Home Opener" football game on Founders Day - Thursday, August 30, at 7:30 pm.

This is a great opportunity to bring different facets of the University together to celebrate the beginning of the 2018-19 academic year. We look forward to hosting Ferris State students, faculty/staff, emeriti, Bulldog football fans, alumni and our opponent the East Stroudsburg Warriors.

One of our biggest challenges in hosting a football game on a Thursday night will be parking.

Here are some important details for parking on campus on Thursday, August 30;

1. Access to the tailgate parking lots for the game can begin at 5 pm. All fans are asked to wait until after 5 pm to arrive on campus for the football game so that FSU employees ending their work day may exit the parking lots.
2. Tailgating will not be allowed to begin until 5:15 pm. Tailgate lots are Lots 35, 36 and 37. A map showing the location of these lots is located at the link below. Lot 2 will be closed for football parking on August 30 due to evening classes in the Swan Building.
3. Our football game day parking attendants will be in place at 4:30 pm to provide information and direction. We will not allow access or collect the parking fee until 5 pm. We will charge our normal football parking fee of \$5 for every parking space needed/used.
4. Students, faculty/staff and others who are on campus for class and/or business purposes will simply need to display their Parking Services issued hanging decal and inform the attendant of their business on campus and they will not be charged.
5. Friends of Ferris, faculty emeriti, retiree's, etc. who are coming onto campus to participate in the Founder's Day

Celebration and Ice Cream Social are encouraged to park in Lot 1 east of the University Center. Additional parking is also available in Lot 13.

6. We are anticipating a very good crowd for this home opening football game so if you are returning to campus or just getting to campus after 4:30 pm on Thursday please anticipate increased traffic and delays in getting to your preferred parking lot and plan accordingly.

7. Kick-off for the football game is 7:30 pm. Tickets will be available for purchase during the week at the Ice Arena Box Office or at the Top Taggart Box Office the day of the game.



## Ferris State Hockey Reserved Season Tickets Now On Sale!

Big Rapids, Mich. - Ferris State University has announced reserved season tickets for the 2018-19 Bulldog men's ice hockey campaign are now on sale.

Fans can guarantee seats for all 20 regular-season home contests as the Bulldogs welcome a big slate of opponents to the Ewigleben Ice Arena for the school's 44th season of collegiate hockey in Big Rapids, which has been voted as one of the nation's top 10 college hockey cities. This year's home schedule features opponents such as Michigan State, Western Michigan, Michigan Tech and more. Overall, the 20 home outings are the school's most in more than a decade.

Seating is expected to be at a premium as the Bulldogs have officially posted more than 25 sellouts overall in the last five years and the "Dawg Pound" student section has recorded upwards of 100 consecutive regular-season home sellouts, making Bulldog Hockey one of the hottest tickets around.

"Bulldog Hockey fans provide an atmosphere that makes our arena one of the nation's toughest venues to play in for opposing teams," said FSU head coach **Bob Daniels**. "It's tremendously entertaining and our players realize how special it is to play in such a big time environment."

Adult season ticket prices for the 2018-19 season are \$225 with seniors (ages 65+) along with FSU faculty/staff prices set for \$205. A student ticket (age 3-17) is \$115 with all current Ferris State student tickets sold for \$99 with valid student identification. In addition, a season parking pass is available for \$80.

Season tickets will remain on sale and must be purchased by Sept. 7 at 5 p.m. (ET). After that date, any unsold seats will be available for the general public to purchase once single-game ticket sales begin on Sept. 12. Forms have been mailed to all past season ticket holders, who are encouraged to renew and reserve their seats as soon as possible.

Fans purchasing season tickets will be allowed to pick the seats of their choice, see a savings of more than \$100 versus purchasing tickets the day of the game, receive first-round WCHA playoff tickets should the Bulldogs host postseason action, earn the first opportunity to buy additional single-game tickets for premium games and will also be eligible for special in-game seating sponsored by Katke Golf Course.

All reserved season tickets must be purchased directly thru the FSU Athletics Ticket Office located in the Ewigleben Sports Complex. The office is open Monday thru Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (ET) at this time with extended hours being offered once the school year begins. For additional information regarding season ticket packages, please call the ticket office at (231) 591-2888.

The Bulldogs, who have reached the NCAA Final Eight three times since 2012, will embark on their 44th campaign this coming fall and again face perhaps one of the country's toughest schedules as they seek their fourth trip to the NCAA Tournament in the last eight years.
