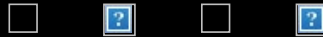

RAD - Rape Aggression Defense Program

The **Rape Aggression Defense Program** is a program of realistic, self-defense tactics and techniques. The Department of Public Safety hosts these programs throughout the academic year. RAD is not a martial arts program.

The RAD System is dedicated to **teaching women defensive concepts and techniques** against various types of assault, by utilizing easy, effective self-defense tactics. This system of realistic defense will provide a woman with the knowledge to make an educated decision about resistance.

Our courses are taught by **Officer Nick Greenway** and **Detective Sergeant Tim Jacobs**, who are certified RAD instructors.

The program is FREE and open to female students, faculty/staff, and community members. To ensure each participant is given the best experience and training in this program, we limit the number of participants to 30. Should DPS receive a high demand for the program, we may offer more classes later this spring.
