## Department of Public Safety – January 2019 Announcements

Welcome back to campus, Bulldogs!

Please take a few minutes to read the announcements below regarding upcoming programs and on-going initiatives that are provided by DPS.

### **Food for Fines**

Beginning February 1st, students with unpaid parking tickets issued during January of 2019 will be able to pay parking fines with **non-perishable, non-expired** food items. Payment must be made in the Parking Office during business hours. DPS will only accept items until end of business February 8th.

Food for Fines "payments" are as follows:

- 5 items are equal to a \$10 ticket
- 10 items are equal to a \$20 ticket
- 2 items are equal to a \$5 late fee
- **\$100 tickets excluded (Fire Lane & Handicap violations)**

**All goods collected will be donated to Wesley House**, the student run food pantry on campus, located at 628 South Warren Avenue, Big Rapids MI. ## Ferris State Basketball Back At Home For Two Big GLIAC Doubleheaders This Week



Big Rapids, Mich. - After a weekend trip to the Upper Peninsula, the Ferris State University men's and women's basketball squads both return home this week for a pair of Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) home doubleheaders inside Jim Wink Arena.

The Bulldogs will first host Purdue Northwest on Thursday (Jan. 17) evening before entertaining new league member Wisconsin-Parkside for the first time ever on Saturday (Jan. 19) afternoon.

The action on Thursday night starts with the women's game at 5:30 p.m. (ET) versus the Pride with the men's game to follow at approximately 7:30 p.m. (ET). Saturday's contests against the Rangers begin at 1 p.m. (ET) for the women and 3 p.m. (ET) for the men.

The Bulldog women's team is presently 7-7 overall this year and ranks third in the GLIAC North Division race with a 4-4 conference slate. The Bulldogs battled first-place Northern Michigan to the end this past Saturday in their last outing and will face a Purdue Northwest team on Thursday evening that is looking for its first conference win as the Pride are 2-12 overall and 0-8 in the GLIAC.

Saturday's opponent, Parkside, owns a 5-9 mark and is 3-5 in the GLIAC heading into a Thursday tilt against Lake Superior State.

The Bulldog men are presently a game out of first place in the GLIAC North as FSU is 12-7 overall and 4-4 in league play after scoring a 62-59 road win over NMU on Saturday in Marquette. The Bulldogs will take on a Pride squad on Thursday that is 6-10 overall, but only 1-6 in the GLIAC. Meanwhile, Parkside is currently tied for first with Lake Superior State heading into their matchup on Thursday. The Rangers are 7-7 overall and 5-3 in the GLIAC.

A year ago, the Bulldog men beat Purdue Northwest 92-78 on the road and by a decisive 117-66 score in the first two matchups ever between the two programs. The Bulldog women also swept the Pride by scores of 94-68 in Hammond (Ind.) and 83-47 in Big Rapids. The two games on Saturday versus Parkside will represent the first-ever league matchups versus the Rangers.

All fans can purchase advance tickets while supplies last for all Bulldog home basketball games to guarantee a seat by visiting the FSU Athletics Ticket Office located inside the Ewigleben Sports Complex. Tickets can also be purchased in advance 24 hours a day, seven days a week online at [StarTickets.com](#) or by calling 1-800-585-3737.

Prices are \$10 for adult general admission along with \$7 for FSU Faculty/Staff and Seniors (ages 65 and up) in addition to \$5 for students (age 3-17 years). All FSU students earn free admission with a valid student ID card.

The FSU Athletic Ticket Office's normal business hours are Monday thru Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (ET) with extended hours on Wednesday until 7 p.m. (ET).
