Ferris State Hockey Returns To Home Ice This Weekend As Playoff Push Heats Up

Big Rapids, Mich. - After a big road win over one of the nation's top 10 teams, the Ferris State University men's ice hockey team returns back home to the Ewigleben Ice Arena this weekend (Feb. 1-2) as the Bulldogs play host to Lake Superior State in Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) action.

The Bulldogs and the Lakers will square off with puck drop both nights set for 7:07 p.m. (ET). The series' opens a February stretch in which FSU will play six of its next eight outings on home ice as the Bulldogs continue their postseason playoff push.

Ferris State is coming off an impressive 3-0 shutout victory over #9 Bowling Green this past Saturday evening at the Slater Family Ice Arena in Ohio.

Meanwhile, the Lakers were ranked among the nation's top 20 teams last week at #18 in the United States College Hockey online (USCHO) poll. Both FSU and LSSU are among a group of teams contending for position in the WCHA standings heading into the final month of the regular-season.

As part of this weekend's series, Saturday will be a premium game with a large crowd expected for the showdown between the two longtime league rivals. FSU will also honor student-athletes and coaches from the fall season as part of the evening activities, including a group of eight All-Americans, football head coach **Tony Annese**, volleyball head coach **Tia Brandel-Wilhelm** along with women's soccer coach **Andy McCaslin** and his staff.

In addition, a ceremonial puck drop will take place prior to the Saturday showdown with Bulldog Football quarterback and 2018 Harlon Hill Trophy winner **Jayru Campbell** slated to drop the puck.

Fans can purchase advance tickets for all Bulldog home hockey games to guarantee a seat and save over the normal gameday rates by visiting the FSU Athletics Ticket Office located inside the Ewigleben Sports Complex. Bulldog fans can also purchase all regular-priced tickets in advance 24 hours a day, seven days a week online at StarTickets.com or by calling 1-800-585-3737.

The FSU Athletic Ticket Office's normal business hours are Monday thru Friday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. (ET) with extended hours on Wednesday until 7 p.m. (ET).

Overall, FSU has posted more than 25 total sellouts at the Ewigleben Ice Arena since the second half of a historic 2011-12 campaign in which the Bulldogs reached the national championship game at the NCAA Frozen Four.

The Bulldogs, who have reached the NCAA Final Eight three times since 2012, are in their 44th campaign this fall and again facing perhaps one of the country's toughest schedules.

Since 2012, the Bulldogs have made three NCAA Tournament appearances and advanced to the NCAA Final Eight all three times. FSU has also won two conference regular-season championships along with capturing the

WCHA's Broadmoor Trophy once as the league's Final Five Champion. Along with a Frozen Four berth and national title game showing in 2012, FSU also has reached the regional final and the final eight of the NCAA Tournament in both 2014 and 2016.

Ferris State Athletics To Honor Fall Standout All-Americans & Coaches Saturday Night



Big Rapids, Mich. – Ferris State University fans are invited to come out and help honor standout athletes and coaches from a highly-successful fall season this Saturday (Feb. 2) night as the Bulldog men's ice hockey team hosts Lake Superior State inside the Ewigeleben Ice Arena.

This Saturday evening, FSU will honor the fall individual All-Americans, Coaches of the Year along with Harlon Hill winner **Jayru Campbell** of Ferris State Football during the Western Collegiate Hockey Association (WCHA) contest. Several coaches will be honored during the first period media stoppages while the All-Americans will be introduced and announced at the first intermission.

Campbell will open the ceremonies with a ceremonial puck drop on Saturday night prior to the 7:07 p.m. (ET) puck drop. The winner of the Harlon Hill Trophy awarded annually to the NCAA Division II Football National Player of the Year, Campbell brought the Harlon Hill back to Big Rapids for the third time in five years, joining two-time recipient Jason Vander Laan (2014, 2015) as the second winner of the award in school history.

The Bulldog football squad finished with five All-Americans who will also be honored as well including senior left tackle **Devon Johnson**, senior guard **Nic Sawyer**, junior defensive end **Austin Edwards** and junior defensive back **Delon Stephenson** in addition to Campbell. Head Coach **Tony Annese** will also be recognized for winning Great Lakes Intercollegiate Athletic Conference (GLIAC) coach of the Year as well as the Hero Sports National Coach of the Year award.

Annese led the Bulldogs to their first National Championship game in school history, a school-record 15 wins and a GLIAC Championship in 2018.

Ferris State women's volleyball will have two All-America honorees recognized, including junior outside

hitter **Allyson Cappel**, who became only the second Bulldog in school history to earn All-America honors three different years, in addition to sophomore outside hitter **Katie O'Connell**.

Meanwhile, Bulldog head coach **Tia Brandel Wilhelm** will also be honored for winning GLIAC Coach of the Year kudos for the sixth time in her career after leading the Bulldogs to a 16-0 conference record and the first perfect GLIAC mark since 1990 for Ferris State. The Bulldogs won both their fifth consecutive GLIAC Regular Season and Tournament Championships in the fall.

Also slated to be recognized will be the Bulldog women's soccer coaching staff, which was honored as the 2018 United Soccer Coaches Association Regional Staff of the Year. Head coach **Andy McCaslin** and his staff was the Midwest Region's recipient at the NCAA Division II level following a NCAA Division II Sweet Sixteen finish. FSU reached the national tournament for the first time in school history and won its first two games in a historic campaign.

Finally, the Bulldogs will also honor junior women's cross country standout **Katie Etelamaki**, who earned All-America honors at the 2018 NCAA Division II National Championships. She placed 16th overall in the women's 6K event as she clocked 23:07.4 in earning All-America laurels.
