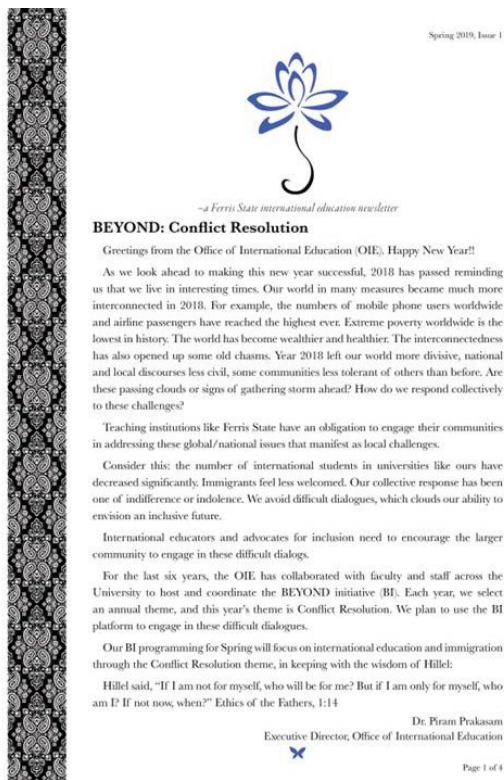

Office of International Education Spring 2019 Newsletter - Issue #1

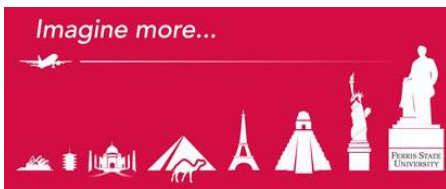

Instructure: Canvas Demonstration and Pilot

The eLearning Management Advisory Team (EMAT) has created a Learning Management System (LMS) Review Subcommittee that is made up of 34 faculty members. The subcommittee has scheduled three LMS demonstrations including D2L's Brightspace on 11/8/18 and 11/9/18, Instructure's Canvas on 1/24/19 and 1/25/19, and Blackboard's Learn Ultra on 3/21/19 and 3/22/19.

What Can I Share and Who has Access to My Files in OneDrive for Business

OneDrive is the Microsoft cloud service that connects you to all your files. It lets you store and protect your files, share them with others, and get to them from anywhere on all your devices. When you use OneDrive with your Ferris provided accounts, it's known as OneDrive for Business. OneDrive for Business is an integral part of the Office 365 suite of applications and services and where you can store, share, and sync your work files. Sharing files is just one of the many benefits of utilizing the OneDrive for Business application.

What Can I Share and Who has Access to My Files in OneDrive for Business?

OneDrive for Business allows you to store files and folders of any type and from any device. As part of the service of storing files and folders, you can also setup sharing for these same items with any number of people within the University and externally. Sharing files/folders allows others to access the specified files from their devices. Based on the sharing permissions given by the owner, the people that have been given access to the files/folders can either just view the files or have full editing capabilities. Sharing files/folders allows for better collaboration with colleagues and external business partners by utilizing the same platform to perform the necessary work.


When deciding on what files/folders to share, you have a couple options available to you. You can share individual file one-by-one or you can create a folder with files within and share the entire folder. When setting up a shared file/folder, you can easily search the University address book for people to share your files/folders with and they will receive an email with details about what was shared and how to access that data. In addition to selecting users from the University address book, you can choose to get a link that you can send via email to anyone that you would like to share your files/folders with. When choosing this option, you can choose whether people with this link can edit or just read the files shared within.

Either way you choose to share your files/folders, the only people that can access/see your data are you and the individuals you've selected to see/edit your files or folders. That's it. Nobody else has access to your OneDrive for Business data. For more information about sharing files/folders, click [here](#).
