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Students, members of Ferris' faculty and staff, and community members are invited to participate in a two-hour salary negotiation workshop **on Tuesday, April 2**, which will be hosted by the Ferris Women's Network.

The Start Smart session, developed by the American Association of University Women includes facilitated discussion and role play designed to help participants identify and speak to their personal value, structure their responses and strategies for effective negotiation and to conduct objective research on the market, so their compensation for salary and benefits is reasoned and credible.

Faculty, staff, and members of the community are encouraged to attend this session, as it will focus on writing value statements and developing negotiating skills.

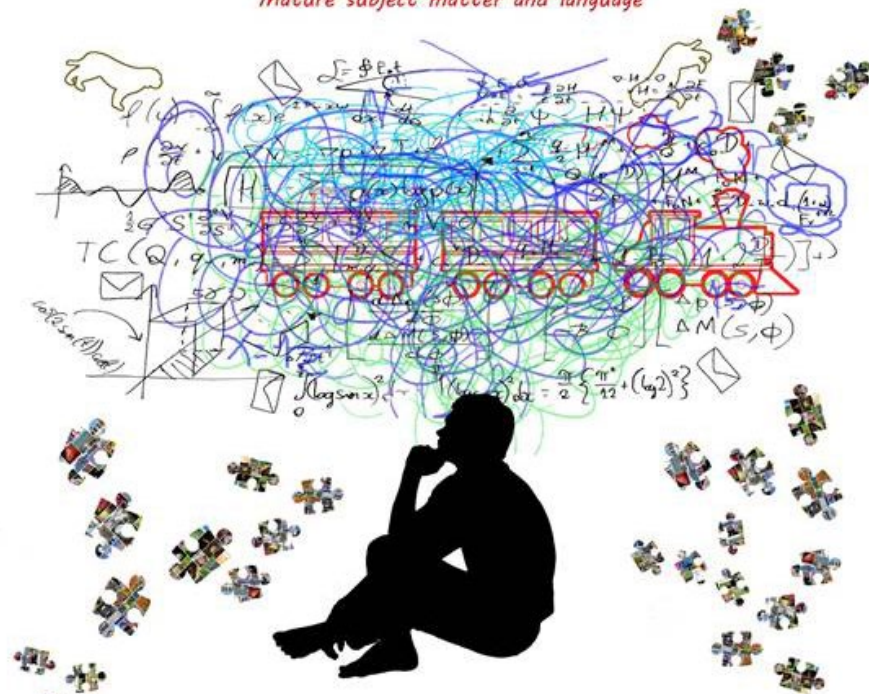
