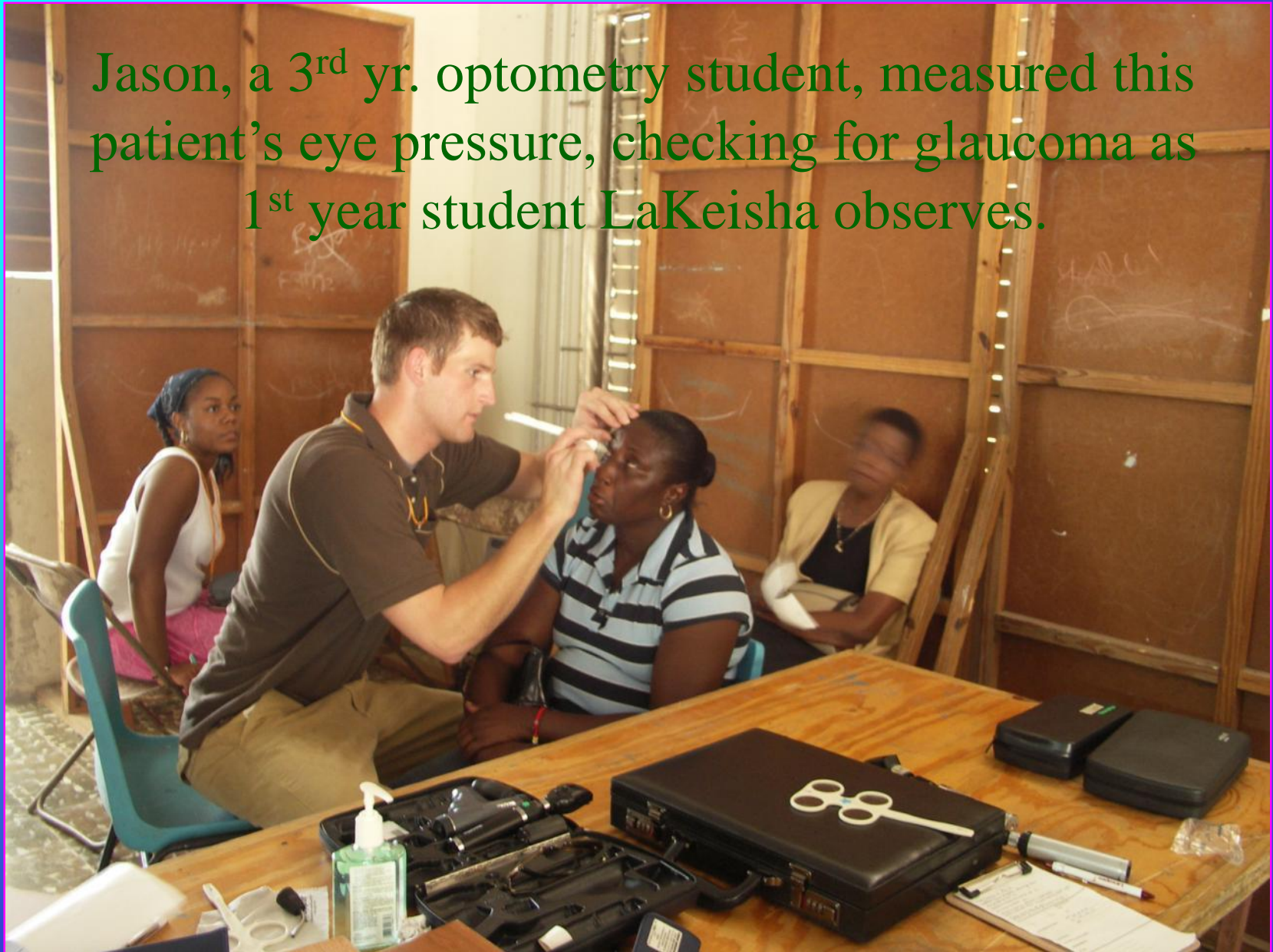

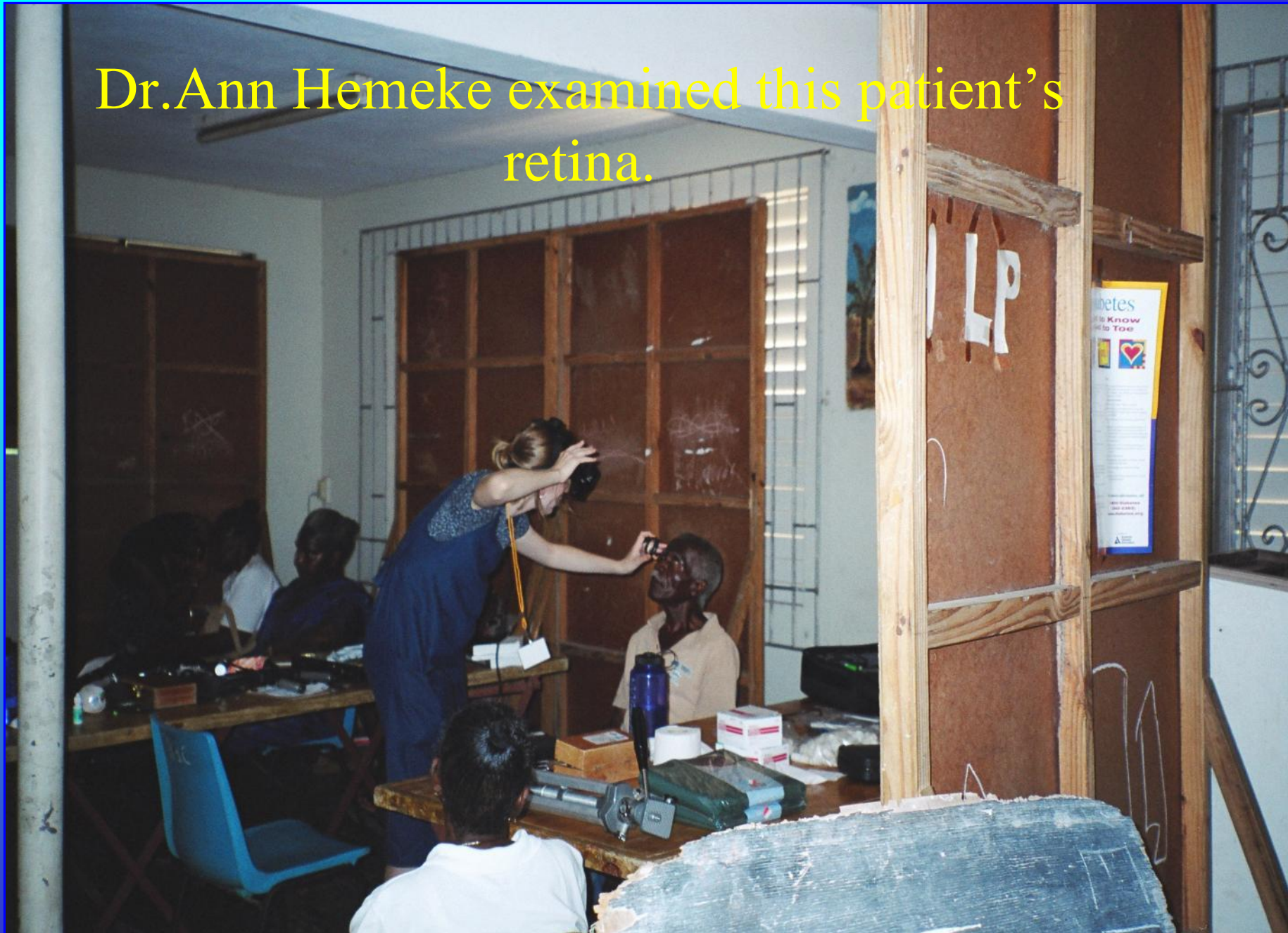

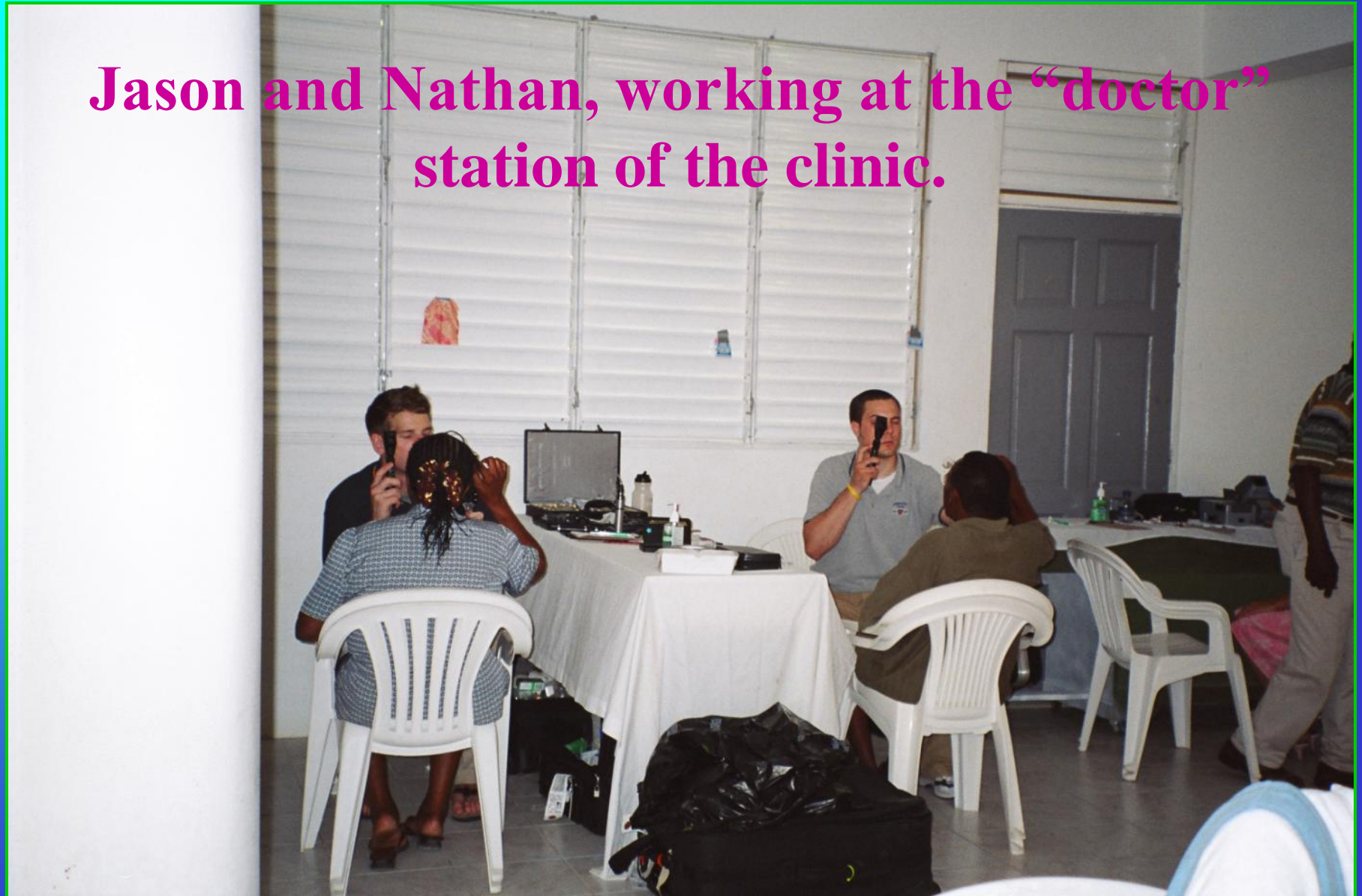
Jason, a 3rd yr. optometry student, measured this patient's eye pressure, checking for glaucoma as 1st year student LaKeisha observes.

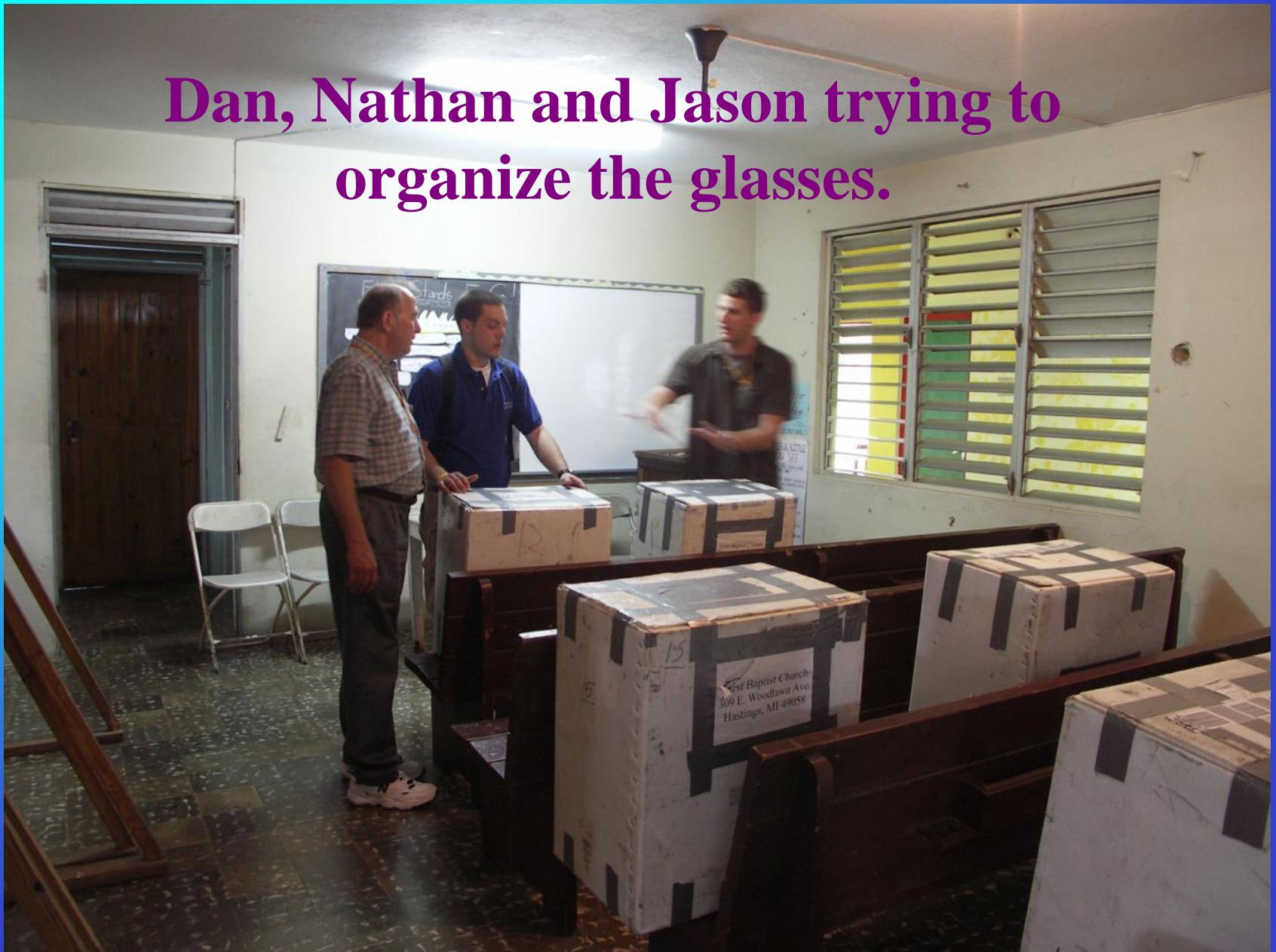

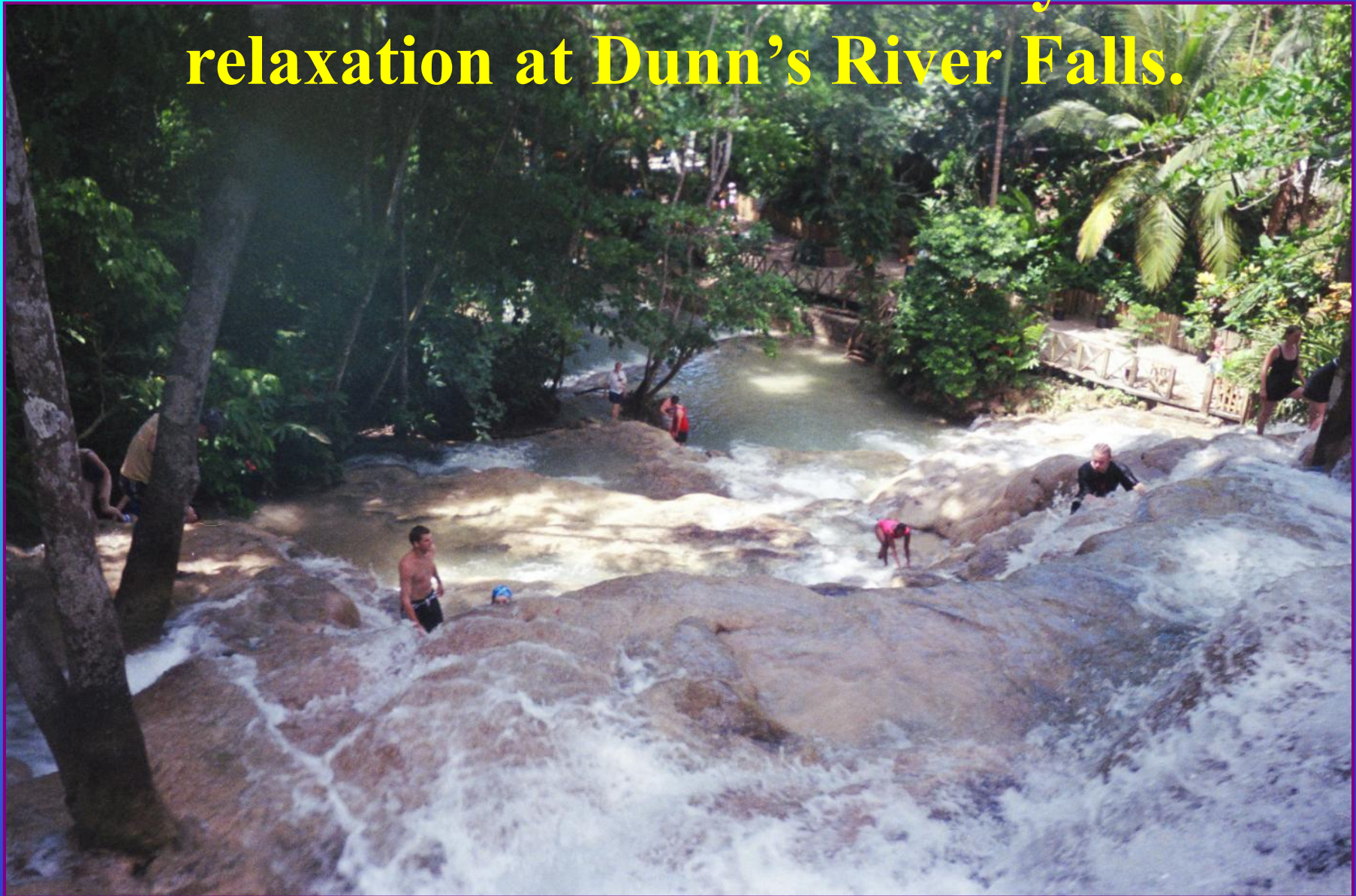
