Counseling Center

The Counseling Center provides a place where students can have conversations with licensed counselors who provide a supportive and understanding environment. Where students seek counseling for a variety of concerns.

New Wellness Room

The Wellness Room is private space designed to improve the quality of student's mental and physical health. This is a quiet space with comfortable seating, light therapy, and de-stressing activities available to individual students on a drop-in basis.

We ask that visitors unplug from technology and do not bring homework into the space to take advantage of the opportunity to be present and practice being mindful.

The Wellness Room is located on the second floor of the Birkam Health Center building. To use the space, check-in at the Personal Counseling Center's front desk located on the second floor.
