Guest Student Policy

Adopted 10/29/20

A student seeking to take a course in the Doctor of Pharmacy program at Ferris State University must meet one of the following criteria:

- Enrolled in another accredited Doctor of Pharmacy program
- Capable of returning to their previous accredited Doctor of Pharmacy program upon successful completion of the requested Ferris coursework
- Graduate of an accredited Doctor of Pharmacy Program
- Licensed or formally licensed as a pharmacist in the United States.

Guest Student Stipulations:

- The student must complete the “Guest Student Application” and submit it to the Director of Admissions. The Admissions Committee will consider the request.
- If a conditional admission is granted, the guest student applicant must contact the Ferris State University Office of Admissions for further instructions in order to officially enroll in the course as a guest student.
- If the guest student wishes to transfer the credit earned from the coursework taken at the FSU College of Pharmacy, it is their sole responsibility to ensure transferability of the coursework to their home institution to meet their requirements.
- The tuition rate for the courses taken by the guest student will be the standard Pharm.D. tuition rate at the time the course is taken.
- The guest student must abide by all the course and programmatic requirements, as applicable (e.g., laptop requirement, Face-to-Face Instruction, etc.).
- The COP guest student status expires after two semesters.
