OVERNIGHT VISITATION PROGRAM

(Supersedes RLPL 2004:02)

- I. Roommates and suitemates must prearrange rules concerning guests and overnight visitors. The overnight visitation program permits not more than two overnight guests per room per night. Guests include anyone not assigned to the room or suite. All guests must adhere to the escort policy and all rules and regulations of Ferris State University. Residents are responsible for guests and guest behavior and may receive a student conduct referral for policy violations. Unruly guest behavior may result in the guest's immediate removal and ban from campus housing. The University reserves the right to limit frequency of visits when the rights of the roommates or suitemates are compromised. Guests may not stay more than two consecutive nights and/or more than 10 nights per semester without prior approval from the Office of Housing and Residence Life.
- II. Child Visitation: All guests under the age of 18 must have a letter signed by a parent granting permission to visit and stay on campus. Children under the age of six (6) are not permitted as overnight guests. Visitation for children under the age of six (6) is from 8:00 a.m. to 9:00 p.m. daily. A parent or guardian must accompany children under the age of six (6) at all times.
