Open Educational Resources (OER)

Kristy Motz gave an update on the success of the OER program and urged faculty to consider this option when thinking about textbooks for their courses. Many resources are free-on-line and most hard copies run \$15.00 - \$55.00 at most. Benefits are obviously the cost but also the ability to customize.

New Strategic Plan

Each of the five groups asked the SPARC members to provide feedback on one initiative for their goals. The groups are Academic Program Offerings, Pride and Community, Enhancing Resources, Student Success and Institutional Effectiveness.

On-Line Education

Amy Green explained some of the types of on-line learning such as blended, which is 30% of the class being taught on-line, digital, which is no physical instructor and on-line, which is an internet connection between the student and teacher. Some of the reasons to offer on-line classes are flexibility and social and emotional health and safety. Ways we support on-line students is through new student orientation and support services such as math tutoring, the writing center and counseling services. For faculty members that bring the content, the University has instructional design experts to assist with designing their on-line class.
