Workgroups Established

- Engaged faculty, staff and students to serve on workgroups developing specific planning measures for the following areas:
 - Health/Testing
 - Academics
 - Facilities
 - PPE Procurement
 - Employee Resources/Customer Service
 - Students

Third Phase

- Phase three August 24 through December 21 (Full return to in-person campus operations)
- Classes are in session with a mix of remote/online, HyFlex and face-to-face delivery methods
- Creating new ways to engage students on campus
- Continuing to monitor COVID-19 cases on campus and the community

Asking Everyone To...

- Complete required, daily symptom checker
- Wear face coverings as directed
 - fit snugly but comfortably against the side of the face
 - be secured with ties or ear loops
 - include multiple layers of fabric
 - allow for breathing without restriction
- Social Distance 6 feet apart
- Don't come to work/class, if sick
- Practice good hygiene wash hands frequently
- Avoid large gatherings
- Report positive status to your supervisor/HR or Birkam (students)
- Report non-compliance with University COVID-19 directives

Covid Testing, Surveillance and Interventions

- Testing
 - Symptomatic and close contact
 - Housing residents, athletes, dining
- Surveillance
 - Symptom checker, waste stream analysis, contact tracing
- Interventions
 - Isolation, quarantine, additional testing

Academics

- Academic delivery methods (as of 9-14-2020):
 - Face-to-face 36%
 - Hyflex 12%
 - Remote/online 40%
 - Practicums and independent studies 12%
- After Thanksgiving: remote class delivery where possible/University offices remain open
- Grading: Option of credit/non-credit after grades submitted

Facilities

- MicrobeCare spray used throughout campus
- HVAC study completed added 42 air scrubbers added to classrooms
 - Automotive Building, Bishop Hall, Prakken Building, Swan Building, West Commons, Southwest Commons, and Creative Arts Center
- Social Distance study in classrooms
- Faculty mobile barriers in place
- Cleaning supplies and masks
- Classroom technology to facilitate HyFlex classrooms
- Outfitted University Center ballrooms for use as higher-capacity classrooms
- Traffic and density lighter than expected in most buildings
- Most academic lounge spaces closed/vending machines unavailable
