Updates

Vice President Scoby announced the April 25th start date for AVP for Human Resources Jan Blair, revisions to the project for improvements to the soccer field and intramural fields, anticipated razing of older apartment buildings, construction of West Campus apartments to be open for fall 2016, and the summer construction start for the north end residence hall to be open fall 2017.
