Chair Spence Tower called the meeting to order. Dates for the summer retreat will be presented at the April meeting. Chair Tower introduced Provost Blake to present the Higher Learning Commission Quality Improvement and President Eisler to discuss the budget and possible additional sources of revenue.

Higher Learning Commission

Provost Blake shared progress on the HLC Quality Initiative. The Center for Academic Literacies is the Quality Initiative that we are working on that will help eliminate road blocks to learning and boost retention in the process. By next fall he hopes to have a visual presence of the Center for Academic Literacies in FLITE.

He introduced Jennifer Hegenauer who talked through Quality Improvement document and answered questions from SPARC members.

Budget

President Eisler presented a synthesis of the slides from the three budget forums on campus. These presented the continued decline in Michigan high school graduates, provided comparisons for Michigan public universities and highlighted enrollment declines at Ferris and the resulting impact on the Ferris and Kendall budgets.

The Council members were divided into groups and asked to consider ways to generate more revenue for the University to offset declining enrollment.
